SAP Extended Warehouse Management (EWM) is the latest strategic warehouse management solution from SAP. It is a more comprehensive solution with extended features in addition to the classic warehouse management options.

SAP offers EWM in two formats: Basic EWM and Advanced EWM, with the latter being more suitable for warehouses with higher operational complexity. EWM is available in two implementation variants - integrated in SAP S/4HANA or decentralized on an S/4HANA system - both alternatives are available either as an on-premise or cloud solution.

THE ADVANTAGES OF EWM:

Future-proof & S/4HANA compatibility

After 2025, **SAP WM** will only be available in the S/4HANA context as a functionally reduced "Stock Room Management" solution.

SAP EWM is SAP's strategic warehouse solution for S/4HANA and is actively being developed further - including integration into cloud solutions (e.g. RISE & GROW with SAP).

Integrated warehouse automation

EWM-MFS (material flow control) enables the direct control of automation technology (e.g. conveyor technology, high-bay warehouses, AMR, etc.).

SAP EWM offers significantly more features than **SAP WM**, e.g:

- Warehouse task optimization
- Slotting & rearrangement
- Value added services (VAS)
